Introduction

Scorpios was founded in 2015 on a sun-drenched southern tip of Mykonos as a contemporary interpretation of the ancient Greek agora — an inclusive gathering place to galvanize the artistic, spiritual, and social life of its community and encourage people from all walks of life to engage, inspire and revel in conversation.

With a multidimensional wellbeing program blending ancient healing practices with modern artistic exploration, an award-winning Ritual Space, unique music program, diverse culinary offerings and open-air terraces, Scorpios Bodrum is an outpost for our collective at the symbolic crossroads of East and West.

In 2019, Scorpios joined the Soho House family. As a platform for new ideas, synergies and artistic experimentation, Scorpios is a natural fit for Soho House's nomadic community of global changemakers. Scorpios Bodrum marks the first expansion of this partnership.

The Art of Gathering

At the core of the Scorpios philosophy lies a culture of gathering — connecting people and cultures, experiences and rituals, along with inner and outer worlds to enrich the lives of our community. These are spaces of festivity and connection, where music is celebrated and wellbeing rituals connect the body and soul, while inclusive cultural programming brings leading artists and new talent together to share a platform. Scorpios is a place of discovery and flow that invites us all to indulge in shared experiences.



Scorpios Design

As a place, Scorpios is about social choreography: all the manners in which people enjoy themselves, manifest their identities, relate to others, embrace the unknown and express things that are meaningful to them. We design our spaces and experiences in ways that invite social and cultural connection, while rewarding exploration.

With lead design by Lambs And Lions, along with key collaborations from GEOMIM and Studio MacBride, the architecture and interiors of the site combines local authenticity, sustainability and international luxury. Attention to materials, natural color palettes and bright interiors that spill into expansive outdoor areas all characterize an atmosphere of contemplative ambience.

The site was created utilizing locally-sourced materials and innovative design techniques for a sense of harmony and continuity with its natural surroundings. Thick masonry stone walls, inspired by traditional Aegean villages offer both structural integrity and aesthetic authenticity, while wood is widely used for canopies, adjustable shutters and interior elements to foster a warm, natural ambience. Water elements are thoughtfully integrated to elevate a sensory experience and create a smooth transition between architecture and local environment. Further blending interior and exterior areas are green roofs and gardens, which help promote biodiversity.

In 2024 these designs won the AHEAD Awards Ultimate Accolade, and Platinum Certification for Building Design and Construction from LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design).

Music Rituals

Scorpios nurtures a diverse creative community, embracing healers, visual artists, renowned DJs and musicians ranging from the classical to the experimental. With the day's events revolving around sunset rituals, each day of the week is tuned to a unique rhythm — musical journeys guide guests through the ceremony of sundown.

On multiple stages, Scorpios residents and a curated crop of international DJs blend a heady mix of electronic and analogue sounds, a musical assortment that pulls from the trodden sands and dance floors of Burning Man, underground Berlin, and the mystical shores of Tulum. These influences come together at Scorpios to create our own distinctive energy.





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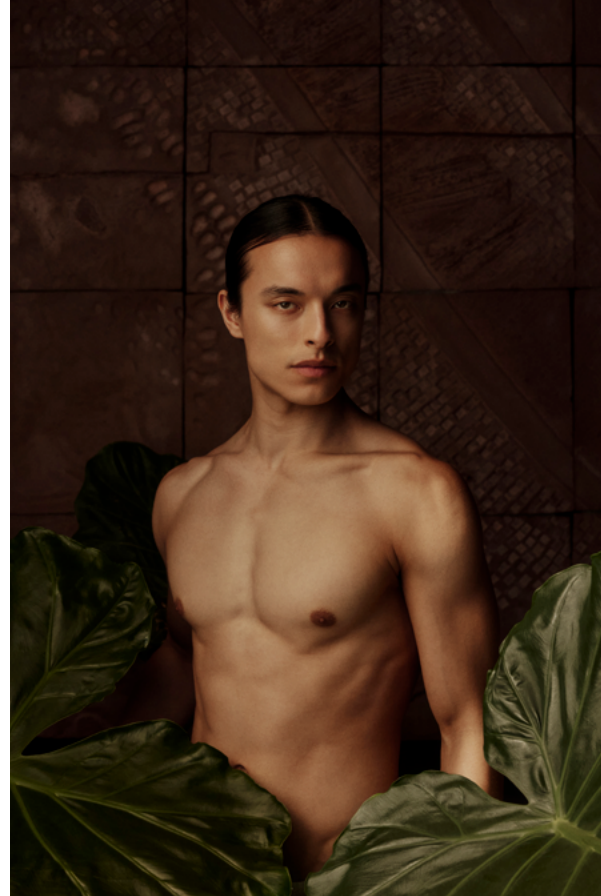


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Music Label and Agency

Our music label, Scorpios Music, brings together a unique array of talents from across the world. Monthly label showcase nights in Bodrum draw some of these artists into focus as well as guest musicians and producers who have worked with us on remixes, instrumentation or vocals. Some of our affiliated acts can be booked via the Scorpios Music agency, including the likes of Jean Claude Ades, Lannka, PAAX, ARKADYAN, Ulises, Ghenwa Nemnom and Little D.



Wellbeing Rituals

Scorpios' wellbeing philosophy celebrates the encounter between ancient healing practices and modern artistic exploration, encouraging guests towards forms of care and nurture that go beyond traditional definitions. We believe that art, sound, movement and community can open up new possibilities for slowing the pace and embracing the natural rhythms of the body.

Now in our third summer, we return with an enriched 2026 Wellbeing Program: an intimate and multi-disciplinary offering that brings together 19 practitioners. From breathwork enhanced by real-time brainwave monitoring to ceremonial performance, ice immersion and silk fan movement, each practice brings something unique — weaving creative expression, health and inner transformation into a single, cohesive experience.

Building on previous editions, the program welcomes back familiar faces whose practices have shaped the Ritual Space over past seasons alongside a new generation of voices joining for the first time. Rodhø & Mulabs lead a standout collaboration exploring longevity, neuroregulation, and brainwave monitoring – culminating in a three-day Neuro-Alchemy retreat in July.

The goal: to leave each guest with meaningful insights and practices they can integrate into their everyday lives.



The Ritual Space

Conceived as a gathering place for Scorpions' growing community, the Ritual Space offers an array of curated experiences designed to nurture both the inner and outer self. The space comprises private treatment rooms, a cold plunge pool, a flotation room, a sound healing dome, a healing terrace, a yoga terrace, an infinity pool as well as relaxation spaces.

At its center stands a contemporary 1,300 sqm brutalist temple, its rectangular ceiling openings allowing light to shift and settle throughout the day. Opposite the temple's opening, the infinity pool is framed by nature and a herbal bar featuring curations from tea sommeliers.

Through the transformative potential of multi-sensory rituals and therapeutic treatments, our Ritual Space is an invitation to immerse in offerings that transcend time and culture.



Scorpions Encounters

Our arts program Encounters continues to showcase artists who push the boundaries of medium, meaning and method. In recent years artworks have included collaborations between Refik Anadol and the indigenous Yawanawá community of Brazil, and Sougwen Chung creating paintings in real time with a bespoke robotic system.

This summer, Scorpions continues its support of pioneering digital and immersive art through a new exhibition showcasing award-winning installations and newly commissioned works that explore the evolving relationship between technology, environment and human expression. More to be announced soon.

All-Around Nourishment

Our food philosophy is to complement and enhance the setting, uniting people in moments of togetherness.

Culinary Director Athinagoras Kostakos and Head Chef Alexis Zopas have constructed menus centered around raw seafood, dishes from the grill and fire, and fresh premium, sourced produce cooked with immediacy. Menus are rooted in the locale through Eastern Mediterranean influences and flavors, while always nodding to our cosmopolitan-minded clientele, carefully balancing a rustic charm with high-level execution.



Nourishment is a central tenet of the F&B ideology at Scorpions, which we see as sitting at the intersection of indulgence and wellness. With long-table dining and plates designed for sharing, we see eating together as a generous social act, rooted in care.

Whether you are celebrating with plenty or simply enjoying a refreshing seabass carpaccio, our food provides for different occasions, moods and appetites – delivering meals that bask in the warm glow of memory long after the final course.

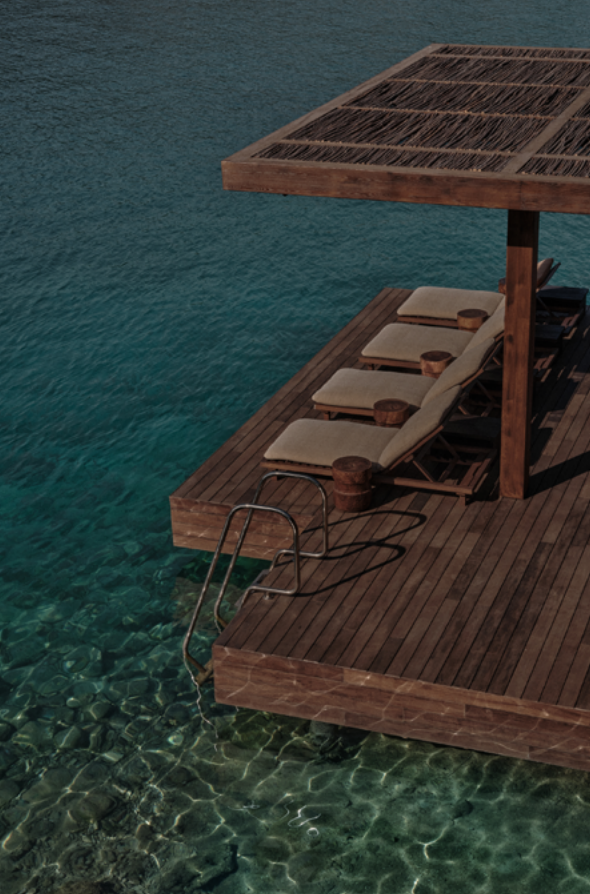
The Terrace

The beating, eclectic heart of Scorpions Bodrum, the Terrace is where we gather to dance. Host to our music ritual events with crowds of over 2000 people, and the space where all guests gravitate as we celebrate under the sunset and stars. Open daily from 5 pm to 1 am. Reservations needed from 5 pm to 8 pm.

The House

With its warm elegance and open layout, the House gives the alluring comfort of a traditional villa with the conviviality of an old friend's summer house. Open daily from 5 pm to 1 am. No reservation required.





The Beach House

A scenic gateway to the water, the Beach House rests on a small hill, arranged in distinct levels that gradually descend to the water. Designed in accordance with Scorprios' organic minimalism, each level caters to a different style of rest. Whether sunbathing on the main terrace, lazing by the water or reading in the quiet shade of a cabana, sunseekers will find their favorite spot to relax.

An ideal location to settle into for the day, the Beach House is a calm and grounding base from which the wider Scorprios Bodrum experience naturally unfolds. It invites guests to move freely between moments of stillness and discovery: lingering in the sun, taking in the landscape, retreating to the Ritual Space for treatments and immersive experiences, or gathering at the restaurant for leisurely meals by the shore. Open daily from 11 am to 8 pm.

Beach House Restaurant

Moments from the water's edge, the Beach House Restaurant is for casual meals and light refreshments in the afternoon glow. Plates constructed to support nourishment that allow simple, quality ingredients to shine, from grilled meat and fish to wholesome, plant-based goodness.

The Scorpions Bazaar

The Scorpions Bazaar honors a carefully curated selection of brands that embody the values of artisanship and design heritage. Our mission is to create a multi-brand marketplace — a bazaar that inspires curiosity and wonder.

The brands at the Scorpions Bazaar are chosen for their dedication to artisanship and storytelling, each with a unique approach to design that combines bohemian aesthetics with cultural heritage.

By representing a select handful of brands, we offer an unexpected and sophisticated retail experience. From artisanal to contemporary finds, including jewelry and accessories, botanical and ancient healing remedies, the Scorpions Bazaar continues to evolve.





Agora Experience

Created for extended stays, monthly and seasonal passes offer uninterrupted access to Scorpions 360 program, inviting guests to move between morning wellbeing sessions, afternoons by the water and evenings shaped by sound, all within a like-minded community. At its core is a belief that a fulfilling lifestyle leaves room for spontaneity, creativity, and unscripted connection — and that lasting wellbeing unfolds at the intersection of pleasure and nurture.

Both seasonal and monthly passes allow routines to form naturally and wellbeing to build over time through consistency and shared experiences. Members also receive personalized biometric guidance, a guided journal, and invitations to the Agora Event Series of meet-the-artist gatherings, curated dinners, and openings — alongside a community portal linking them to the wider Scorpions network.

Moving Forward Together

In 2019 Scorprios joined the Soho House family. Though two distinct brands, Scorprios and Soho House share a singular approach to hospitality that nurtures community, collaboration, and creativity. As a gathering place and digital platform for new ideas, synergies and artistic experimentation, Scorprios is a natural fit for Soho House's nomadic tribe of global changemakers.

Soho House members now have priority access to Scorprios, as well as exclusive access to Soho Roc House in Mykonos. Built around a love of food, music, art and design, both brands reflect a strong sense of place and a relaxed spirit of radical togetherness.

Soho Roc, previously known as San Giorgio under the management of Thomas Heyne and Mario Hertel, has evolved into a cherished destination for members of Soho House. Since then, the relationship has allowed Scorprios a global infrastructure to grow organically whilst Soho House is able to provide its members priority access to Scorprios's unrivaled offering.





Mykonos, Bodrum and Beyond

Some years ago, two nightlife impresarios from southern Germany met on the shores of Ibiza. After years of traveling and sharing ideas, Thomas Heyne and Mario Hertel decided that Mykonos was missing a space where like-minded individuals from all over the world can come together and feed off the exhilarating energy of the island, but to also be a haven of peace, friendship, community and of memorable new experiences. Scorprios was born and the pair never looked back.

Seeing a clear shift from thumping beats to balance-restoring cultural gatherings, Scorprios forms a genre-defying enclave where design and simple pleasures attract in equal measure. The latest addition, Scorprios Bodrum, continues these values across the Aegean Sea, with more developments to come in Greece and Dubai.
