Introduction

Scorpios was founded in 2015 on a sun-drenched southern tip of Mykonos as a contemporary interpretation of the ancient Greek agora — a gathering place meant to galvanize the artistic, spiritual and social life of our community.

At one of the rare beach locations on Mykonos offering uninterrupted views across the Aegean Sea, Scorpios Mykonos encompasses a sandy beach, a white-washed stone house and restaurant, custom-built stages for sunset rituals, and ample open-air terraces spilling out onto the Cycladic coast. This constellation of spaces has at its heart the intention to encourage meaningful connection with both the self and others.

Mindful Design

Together with the Athens-based, award-winning architects Dimitris and Konstantinos Karampatakis of K-studio, interior designer Annabell Kutucu and creative director Michael Schickinger of Lambs and Lions developed a holistic design treatment for Scorpis Mykonos that celebrates traditional craftsmanship and fosters an environment of effortless ease.

A harmonious relationship between land and architecture sets the tone at Scorpis, with natural and earthy hues throughout. With an emphasis on simplicity and an ode to local Greek culture, the design team pioneered their ethos of subtle sophistication, timeless beauty and a value for the imperfect. The materials and textures of the island sit side-by-side with a well-curated selection of artisan-made items — from traditional Berber rugs to weather-worn furniture.

Perched on a ridge between two stunning sandy beaches, hugged by the wild wonder of a protected nature reserve, the sun-blessed peninsula offers panoramic views over the crystal-clear Aegean Sea. The design of the spaces aims to underscore rather than divert attention from this natural spectacle.





Slowed Down Simplicity

With today's hyper-accelerated pace, the need to slow down and restore balance takes on a newfound relevance. Equally essential is an understanding of the tastes of an ever evolving, style-savvy traveler forever in search of unique experiences — ones where ritualistic relaxation is nurtured through transcendental music and soul-nourishing exchanges.

In a clear invitation to unwind, let go and reconnect, a perfect mix of rural charm and understated elegance sets the tone at Scorpions Mykonos.

The spacious location organically spans three areas: from the western sunset lounge, beach and sun bed area, the eastern terraces and sunrise beach, to the restaurant, music lounge and bar area. Central to the 6,000-square-meter property is the gently weather-worn stone house with classic whitewashed stone accents, simultaneously evoking 1960s Greek glamour and contemporary modernism.

Music Rituals and More

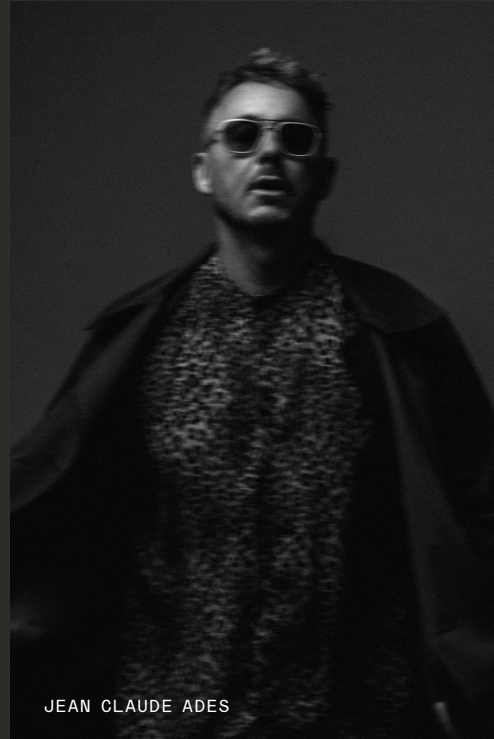
Scorpios nurtures a diverse creative community, embracing healers, visual artists, renowned DJs and musicians ranging from the classical to the experimental. With the day's events revolving around sunset rituals, each day of the week is tuned to a unique rhythm — musical journeys guide guests through the ceremony of sundown.

On multiple custom-crafted stages, Scorpios residents and a curated crop of international DJs blend a heady mix of electronic and analogue sounds, a musical assortment that pulls from the trodden sands and dance floors of Burning Man, underground Berlin, and the mystical shores of Tulum. These influences come together at Scorpios to create our own distinctive energy.

Music Label and Agency

Our music label, Scorpios Music, brings together a unique array of talents from across the world. Scorpios Encounters

Our arts program Encounters continues to showcase artists who push the boundaries of medium, meaning and method. In recent years artworks have included collaborations between Refik Anadol and the indigenous Yawanawá community of Brazil, and Sougwen Chung creating paintings in real time with a bespoke robotic system.

This summer, Scorpios continues its support of pioneering digital and immersive art through a new exhibition showcasing award-winning installations and newly commissioned works that explore the evolving relationship between technology, environment and human expression. More to be announced soon.

All-Around Nourishment

Our food philosophy is to complement and enhance the setting, uniting people in moments of togetherness.

Culinary Director Athinagoras Kostakos and Head Chef Alexis Zopas have constructed menus centered around raw seafood, dishes from the grill and fire, and fresh premium, sourced produce cooked with immediacy. Menus are rooted in the locale through Eastern Mediterranean influences and flavors, while always nodding to our cosmopolitan-minded clientele, carefully balancing a rustic charm with high-level execution.



Nourishment is a central tenet of the F&B ideology at Scorpions, which we see as sitting at the intersection of indulgence/celebration and wellness. With long-table dining and plates designed for sharing, we see eating together as a generous social act, rooted in care.

Whether you are celebrating with plenty or simply enjoying a refreshing seabass carpaccio, our food provides for different occasions, moods and appetites – delivering meals that bask in the warm glow of memory long after the final course.

The House

The Beach

The Beach is located on a naturally sheltered part of the island, offering uninterrupted sea views and a relaxed setting. It's a flexible shoreline venue where the textures and materials of the island come together as one setting.

Care & Remedy Spa

Located nearby the beach, the Spa area at Scorpions Mykonos offers a counterpoint to moments of intensity and celebration, creating space for restoration and inviting guests to engage the body with the elements and the rhythm of the island.

Massages and treatments are supported by curated, vegan-friendly products, crafted from botanicals and plant-based ingredients.

The Sunset Beach

A prime spot on the island to watch the sun disappear over the Aegean, the Sunset Beach offers stunning views and an ambiance that encourages guests to pause and appreciate the present moment. This area is also where Scorpions' signature music rituals take place, musical journeys that guide guests through the ceremony of sundown.

The Restaurant

The Restaurant is a gathering place inspired by ancient communal life, featuring long tables and open-air settings with views of the water. The menu blends Mediterranean cuisines, featuring a family-style sharing plates that encourage leisurely meals communal dining.

The Terrace

Set high above the beach and affording endless views over Paraga, Kavos lagoons and into the vastness of the sea beyond. Home to a variety of music events, every Tuesday, Thursday, and Sunday, resident artists and guest DJs play their upbeat live sets into the night.



To Mykonos and Beyond

Some years ago, two nightlife impresarios from southern Germany met on the shores of Ibiza. After years of traveling and sharing ideas, Thomas Heyne and Mario Hertel decided that Mykonos was missing a space where like-minded individuals from all over the world could come together and feed off the exhilarating energy of the island.
